Anne-Marie is working for Aviagen Group (chicken, turkey) as Group Vice President Welfare and Compliance since May 2011.

This includes: welfare and sustainability within and outside the company. Within the company, she has, for instance, set up global welfare audit system with internal and official external audits, close to the business, in chicken and turkey. Outside the company, she represents the international Poultry Council at FAO related initiatives, she chairs the IPC Environment and Sustainability Working Group and is involved in various other policy and communication initiatives on the poultry business. The latter is always on request of local Aviagen responsibles and often via poultry associations. Items are welfare, sustainability, biodiversity, and the image of poultry business. She has also set up a patent watch, a Code of Good Practice for Animal Breeding Organisations (Code-EFABAR), an EU recognised technology platform on animal breeding (FABRE TP) and initiated the 'Animal Task Force' in Europe.
