



Dr. Barbara Padalino graduated in Veterinary Medicine at the University of Bari (Italy) in 2002 and in 2017 completed her PhD entitled “Transportation of horses and the implications for health and welfare” at the University of Sydney, Australia. She currently works as a researcher in animal science at the Department of Veterinary Medicine, University of Bari (Italy) and as Assistant Professor in animal behaviour and welfare at the College of Veterinary Medicine City University & Cornell University (Hong Kong).
